## **Highlights**

- Drilling contractor engaged for up to 1,000m of RC drilling at Contessa
- Program to test new IP anomaly recently identified in close proximity to supergene gold mineralisation
- Drilling expected to commence before the end of June

West Australian gold explorer Lodestar Minerals Limited (ASX: LSR, "Lodestar" or "the Company") advises that it has engaged a drilling contractor to complete an initial program of up to 1,000m of RC drilling to test a new Induced Polarisation (IP) anomaly recently identified at the Contessa gold prospect<sup>1</sup>. Contessa is located within Lodestar's 100%-owned Ned's Creek project on the northern Yilgarn margin, where extensive supergene and surface gold anomalism occur for over 5km along a sheared granite contact.

Lodestar's previous, widely spaced, RC drilling beneath saprolite gold mineralisation intersected extensive alteration and disseminated sulphide (pyrite) mineralisation associated with gold in the bedrock. The IP survey was intended to identify areas of greater sulphide abundance that could potentially represent a focus for bedrock gold mineralisation.

Ausdrill Northwest has been contracted to complete the RC program and drilling is expected to commence before the end of this month, subject to weather conditions.
